This product may be used only in the following states: Alabama, Arkansas, California, Florida, Georgia, Louisiana, Mississippi, New Mexico, North Carolina, Oklahoma, South Carolina, Tennessee, Texas.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Over 'n Out!™ Fire Ant Killer Granules Insecticide controls imported fire ants in residential lawns. To control other insect pests that may be present such as mole crickets, fleas, and chinch bugs you may use Sevin® brand Granular Carbaryl insecticide. Fire ants begin to die within 7-14 days. Complete control can be expected in as little as three weeks. Apply in the spring then water in immediately after application.

SPECIFIC USE DIRECTIONS

Make application with broadcast or drop spreader to your entire lawn to prevent imported fire ants from establishing and/or to control existing populations.

Measure your lawn to calculate the square feet (= Length X Width of lawn area) and evenly distribute Over 'n Out!™ Fire Ant Killer Granules across the entire lawn. Apply at a rate of 2 pounds per 1,000 square feet (a 10 pound bag will treat 5,000 square feet). Apply water to treated area immediately after application.

TO CONTROL FIRE ANT MOUNDS IN YOUR YARD:

Apply Over 'n Out!™ in the spring to control fire ants in the treated area for up to one season. Fire ants begin to die within 7-14 days after treatment and control can be expected within 6 weeks.

TO PREVENT FIRE ANT MOUNDS FROM FORMING:

Apply a broadcast treatment in the early spring, when the weather is cooler and fire ants are dormant, to prevent mounds from becoming active again in the springtime.
